Dear Sir or Madam:

Re: Parking Concerns – Arthur Street North

Please be advised that staff have recently received concerns regarding the narrow width of Arthur Street North and vehicles parking on the east side of the street making it difficult for vehicles to exit from residential driveways on the west side of the street. City staff have conducted a review of the existing on-street parking restrictions. As a result of this review, staff are prepared to recommend the implementation of a “No Parking” zone on the east side of Arthur Street North along the frontage of Arthur Street North provided there is enough residential support for the restriction.

Therefore, we are asking that prior to Friday, May 23rd, 2008 please indicate your preference:

A) No change to existing on-street parking on Arthur Street North.

OR

B) Implement a “No Parking” zone on the east side of Arthur Street North between the private driveways for #259 and #253 Arthur Street North.

We will accept one response from each residence, and based on these responses, staff will determine whether a “No Parking” zone will be implemented. Please note that for staff to recommend a change to on-street parking restrictions, 75% of those residents affected must respond in favour of the restriction.
