## Re: Parking Concerns – Dumbarton Street

Please be advised that City staff have recently received concerns regarding sightline hazards for vehicles travelling down the street and vehicles exiting from private driveways along the west side of Dumbarton Street, due to vehicles parking along the inner curve of the street along the frontage of 49-61 Dumbarton Street, City staff have conducted a review of the existing parking restrictions on Duke Street.

To address safety concerns and maintain traffic flow, staff are prepared to recommend the implementation of a "No Parking" zone located on the east side of Dumbarton Street.

Therefore, we are asking that <u>prior to Friday, May 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2008</u> please indicate your preference:

A) No change to existing on-street parking on the west side of Dumbarton Street

OR

B) Implement a "No Parking" zone on the west side of Dumbarton Street along the frontage of 49-61 Dumbarton Street.

We will accept one response from each residence, and based on these responses, staff will determine whether to implement the proposed changes to the on-street parking on Dumbarton Street.

Please note that for staff to recommend the implementation of a "No Parking" zone, 75% of those residents affected must respond in favour of the restriction.
